*The Health Service Executive, in partnership with the Postgraduate Training Bodies, is establishing a number of Aspire/Post CSCST Fellowships to commence in July 2022 in key areas of need within the Health Service. Applications are now invited for the position of **Aspire/Post CSCST Fellowship based in the Adult ADHD Service, CHO 6**. This is a one year fixed term contract. This post offers an opportunity for doctors who have completed the Higher Specialist Training program in psychiatry, for further subspecialty training in the area of Adult ADHD and to develop advanced clinical skills.*

The Adult ADHD service is a recently developed specialist multidisciplinary team in CHO6 and is part of the National Clinical Programme for ADHD in Adults. The service conducts specialist assessment of referrals with Adult ADHD and comorbid disorders as well providing specialist training to primary and secondary health services and other stakeholders in the CHO 6 region. The service also integrates clinical work with research and service evaluation. The successful applicant will gain experience conducting specialist assessments of referrals, teaching, research and the process of service evaluation. Training in the standardised assessment protocol and instruments will be provided. Additionally, the close links with the National Clinical Programme for ADHD in Adults will provide experience in management and policy formation.

All applicants must be currently registered with the Irish Medical Council (IMC) and will have completed Higher Specialist Training in psychiatry.
